What are ESSER Funds?



ESSER Funds (Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Funds) were awarded through three separate acts:

Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES)

Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA)

American Rescue Plan Act (ARP)

ESSER Funds Allowable Uses: Related to preventing, preparing for, and responding to COVID-19.

ESSER I

HCSD Allocation: \$809.092.00

-Any activity under ESEA, IDEA, the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act, Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006, or McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act

- -Provide principals and school leaders with resources to address the needs of the school
- -Training and PD for staff on sanitation and minimizing the spread of infectious diseases
- -Purchasing supplies to sanitize and clean the facilities
- -Planning for and coordinating long-term closures,
 - -Purchasing of educational technology
- -Providing mental health services and supports
- -Planning and implementing summer learning and supplemental afterschool programs

 Must be obligated by Sept. 30, 2022

ESSER II

HCSD Allocation: \$3,204,776.00

ALL of the allowable activities from ESSER I in addition to the following:

- -Addressing learning loss among students
- -School facility repairs and improvements
- -Inspection, testing, maintenance, repair, replacement, and upgrade projects to improve the indoor air quality in school facilities

Must be obligated by Sept. 30, 2023

ARP ESSER

HCSD Allocation: \$7,048,014.00

ALL of the allowable activities from ESSER I and II in addition to the following requirement:

-At least 20% of funds must be reserved to address learning loss through the implementation of evidence-based interventions and ensure that those interventions respond to students' social, emotional, and academic needs and address the disproportionate impact of COVID-19 on the underrepresented student subgroups.

Must be obligated by Sept. 30, 2024
